

Part-Time Therapist

The Community House is seeking a Part-Time LCSW/LCPC who is passionate about helping people heal and reach their full potential through providing counseling services, with a specific focus on child, adolescent, and young adult mental health care. Based in Hinsdale and serving the surrounding communities, The Community House is a multi-service organization which provides recreation and cultural activities, counseling and therapeutic services focused on mental health, education support, and volunteer opportunities. The vision of The Community House Counseling Center is to offer equitable access to mental health services to all communities with a specialization in adolescent/young adult services.

Position Responsibilities:

The staff therapist reports to the Director of Social Impact.

- Direct counseling and psychotherapy (85% of time):
- Provide on-going assessment and psychotherapy services to assigned clients both in-person, utilizing telehealth platforms, and in school settings.
- Maintain timely and appropriate clinical and administrative documentation as detailed in this document and the Counseling Policies and Procedures Manual.
- Prepare additional reports as requested by Department Director. Professional Development (5% of time):
- Participate in Case Consultation Groups, and Clinical Case Staffing Meetings.
- Adhere to departmental procedures as described in The Community House Policies and Procedures Manual & TCH Mental Health Services Policies and Procedures Manual. Adhere to the ACA Code of Ethics.
- Other related duties as assigned.

This position is part time; 15-20 hours a week. The position offers flexibility.

Qualifications:

- Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) OR Licensed Clinical Professional Counselor (LCPC)

- Master's Degree in Social Work or Counseling from an accredited program with a valid Illinois license (or the ability to obtain one within 30 days of employment) and experience providing mental health services to adolescents and young adults required.

Desired Requirements:

- An effective communicator who creates a good first impression and earns the trust and respect of others, relating well to people from diverse backgrounds.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office products.

Benefits:

- You will be eligible to participate in The Community House's benefit plans pursuant to their terms, as such plans may be amended from time to time and/or terminated by management in its sole discretion.
- Paid CEUs
- Part-Time employees after working 1000 hours or more in the first year of work begin accruing vacation hours and paid time off (PTO) on January 1st. following their first full year of service. Part-Time employees working 1000 hours their first year receive 26 vacation hours which accrue at 2.17 hours per month and 20 PTO hours which accrue at 1.67 hours per month. Unused PTO hours may not be carried over to the following calendar year.
